




Valparaiso - Monday, January 26



West Lafayette - Friday, January 30






The Purdue Pest Management Program is offering a series of Crop Management Workshops (CMWs) to be held at five locations throughout Indiana. The topics of these meetings are adapted from the previous cropping year, new technologies, questions asked by agribusiness personnel, and suggestions from past CMWs. Certification credits for Indiana's commercial (**not** private) pesticide applicators and Certified Crop Advisors will be awarded to attendees. Credits for Ohio commercial applicators have been requested.

Seating is limited, so register early. Registration is available online with a credit card at www.conf.purdue.edu/crop; click on the Crop Management Workshop you want to attend. Should it be necessary to cancel this program, registered participants will receive a full refund of program fees paid. In the event of such cancellation, however, Purdue University shall not be responsible for any other expenses incurred by the registrant.
