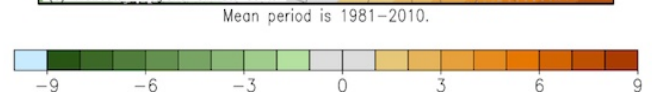
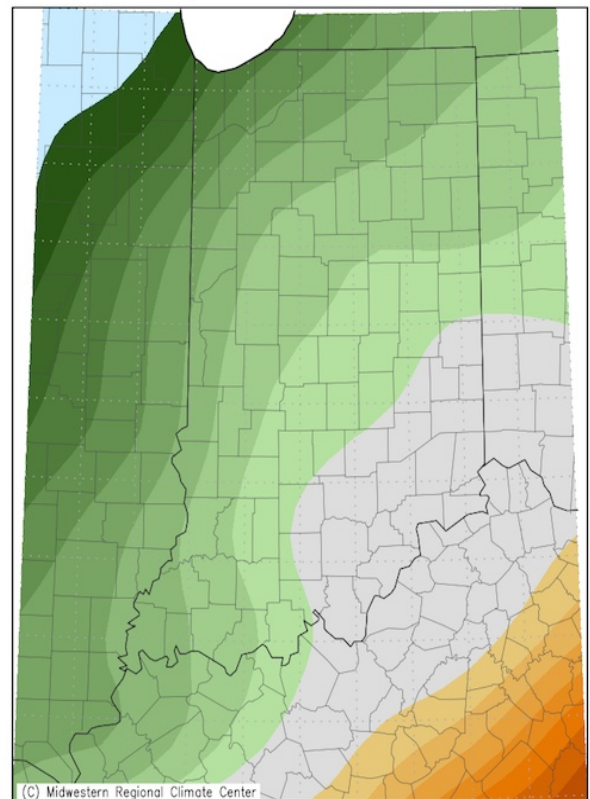

## Current Temperatures And Rainfall

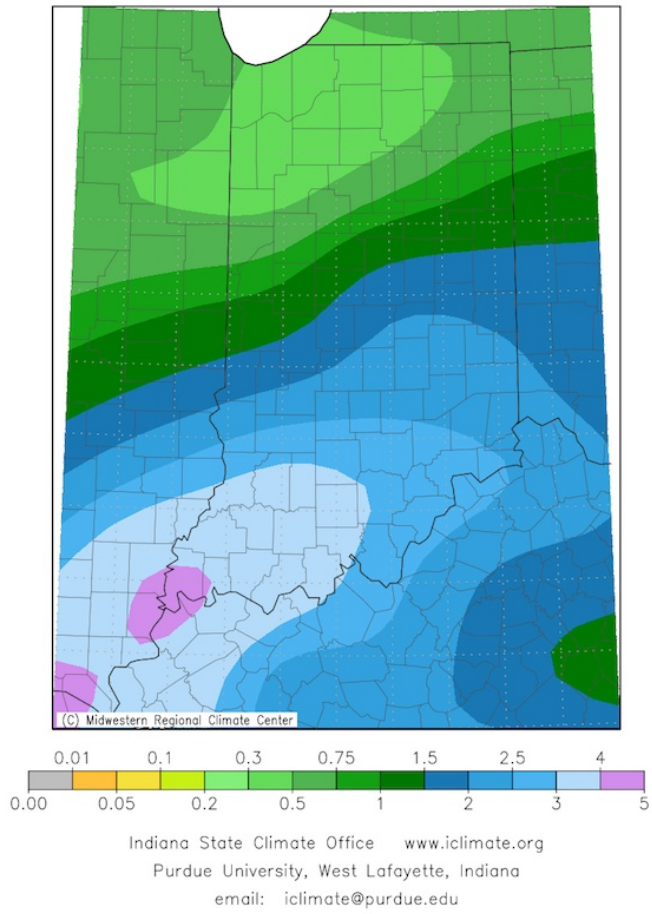
