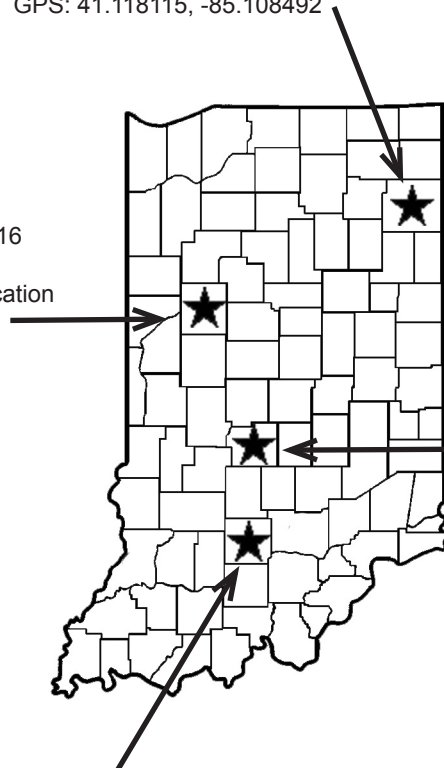

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Purdue Pest Management Program is offering a series of Crop Management Workshops (CMWs) to be held five times throughout Indiana. The topics of these meetings are adapted from the previous cropping year, new technologies, questions asked by agribusiness personnel, and suggestions from past CMWs. Certification credits for Indiana's commercial (CCH) and private (PARP) pesticide applicators and Certified Crop Advisors (CEU) will be awarded to attendees. Credits for Ohio applicators have been requested.

All efforts will be made to hold these meetings as scheduled. Should it be necessary to cancel this program at a moment's notice (e.g., host county emergency road closures), registered participants will receive a full refund of program fees paid if requested.
